Format:

- Enlist 160 people to pray in 15 minute intervals
 - **November 3** = 14 Hours
 - 5:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m.
 - **November 4** = 14 Hours
 - 5:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m.
 - **November 5** = 12 Hours (Elections Day)
 - 7:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m. (Time frame polls are open)
- Prayer Guide Suggestion (A.C.T.S.)
 - 3.5 Minutes = prayers of adoration
 - **Psalm 96:1-4**
 - 3.5 Minutes = prayers of confession
 - **1 John 1:9; James 4:17**
 - 3.5 Minutes = prayers of thanksgiving
 - **1 Thessalonians 5:16**
 - 4.5 Minutes = prayers of supplication (Specific Focus For Our Nation/Election)
 - **Philippians 4:6-7**
 - **Hebrews 4:16**
 - **Proverbs 14:34**

How To Pray For Your Nation:

- The Church
 - That we may be ***“filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God”***—**Colossians 1:9-10.**
 - That a spirit of repentance and humility will be cured out upon the people of God—**Matthew 3:2; 1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 7:10**
 - That we may be faithful ambassadors for Christ—**2 Corinthians 5:20**
- The Voters
 - That they will have wisdom from God—**James 1:5**
 - That discernment between truth and falsehood would be clear—**Romans 12:2**
 - That Christians will be good stewards of their right to vote—**Matthew 5:13-16**
- The Candidates
 - That they will fear the Lord—**Proverbs 1:7**
